National Rebuilding Day

Each year on or around the last Saturday in April, we host our Rebuilding Day, bringing together community teams to



transform homes and change the lives of those we serve. We rely on donations of money, materials and both skilled and unskilled labor to repair homes.

- Individuals can serve as house captains, organizing and managing repairs at each home
- Skilled tradespersons can donate expertise, time and oversight
- Businesses and charitable groups can contribute financial support or in-kind materials

All Year Long We coordinate skilled trades and in-kind donations to repair and revitalize homes, partnering with local social service organizations to identify homeowners whose needs are immediate.

Find People in Need

Referrals are always welcome. Most individuals and families are referred to Rebuilding Together by local social service agencies, villages, cities, community leaders and neighborhood associations. Selfreferrals are also accepted.

We assist homeowners who cannot afford much needed maintenance and repairs on their homes themselves, with a special focus on seniors, persons with disabilities, veterans and families with children. Nonprofit facilities are also eligible.

Homes are inspected and evaluated by a skilled inspector or tradesperson. Selection is based on need, available resources and other eligibility requirements.
